Reportig on EU-POP-Regulation (persistent organic pollutants)

Persistent organic pollutants (POP) are organic substances that are only degraded or converted very slowly in the environment.

POPs include a number of pesticides (e.g. DDT) and industrial chemicals (e.g. polychlorinated biphenyls, PCBs) as well as the highly toxic dioxins and furans, which arise as undesirable by-products in production and combustion processes.

For this reason, attempts have been made for many years at international level to restrict or ban the production and use of certain POPs (Stockholm Convention on POPs).

The implementation of the Stockholm resolutions on the restriction and prohibition of certain POPs has been implemented in the European Union with Regulation (EC) No. 850/2004. This regulation will be replaced by the new regulation (EU) 2019/1021 of June 20, 2019.
